

OP TRAILBLAZE

The local Scarborough Rural police team have created a new operation called **OP TRAILBLAZE** which is a new initiative aimed at addressing the growing problem of offroad motorbikes and vehicles causing significant disruption in our local forestry areas. This problem has led to environmental damage, safety concerns, and disturbances to both wildlife and the broader community.
