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## Dear Parents & Carers

This week in Willow class we have been reading a non fiction book on dinosaurs. We have been learning facts about lots of different dinosaurs. We have made our own fossils using black card and cotton buds. In PE we practiced jumping over cones, and had a go at relay races with varying levels of success!

In Reception the children have been continuing to learn about space and have, this week, learnt about the space race! We have created a timeline as a class of the important events that happened until Neil Armstrong and the moon landing. The children have been fascinated by the first rocket (Rocket V2) and the first satellite (Spudnick 1). This week the children have been learning about doubling and how when doubling we add the same numbers together.

Year 1 have really enjoyed making rose windows in Art. The children were very creative with their designs and worked very carefully whilst using the scissors.

The children are showing a huge interest in Geography at the moment, we are looking at the UK and the children are really impressing us with their enthusiasm and the questions they are asking to find out more information about each country. We would like to take the opportunity to thank the children for their hard work this week!

In Year 2, we have had fun learning about Humanism in Religious Education and exploring the three main rules that Humanists try to live by. In English, we learnt about compound words and practised identifying and using them in our work. In Maths, we continued our learning about 2D and 3D shapes. In Science, we explored why certain materials are used for specific jobs, for example why glass is used for windows.

## Blossom News

This week in the Blossom room the children have been exploring the different effects as the ice blocks melted. They were excited to reveal the hidden treasures, and used the polar bear figures to create adventures. They have been using language to describe their findings "cold" "wet" "frozen" "melting" "glitter" "sparkles" and used lots of number language as they counted the amount and built towers with the ice. They have been creating their own pictures of penguins using shapes to print the different features. They have also been mark making outside with the water and chalks as they practiced writing the sound "O" and drawing different shapes.
