## **Dear Parents & Carers**

Thank you for the positive feedback we received about our VE Day celebrations and the History showcase display. The children really enjoyed it and learnt a lot about what it would have been like to be a child during those times.

Next week will be half term and hopefully the warmer weather will continue so that you can get out and enjoy it. The children have worked so hard this past half term and really do deserve to relax and have some fun.

In Nursery this week we have been learning about animals that live in both the Arctic and Antarctic. In maths we have been learning about the features of 2D shapes. We have also been looking at the different ways we can make 3 and 4. In the playground we have been going on bug hunts and have been building roads for the cars to go down.

This week in Reception we have been learning our number bonds to 10 in maths. We have been learning what numbers can be added together to make a specific total e.g. 4+1 = 5, 3+2 = 5. In PKC we have been finishing off our termly topic of Kings and Queens. The children have really enjoyed learning about our royal family. They have shown a real interest in who they are and their relationships.

To support children's PSED we have been using a scheme called 'Jigsaw'. This week the children were thinking about what a good friend looks like and how to find solutions to problems. In Literacy, we have re-enacted our coronation for King Charles the Bear. The children brought in their teddies and baked their own cupcakes to celebrate.



This week, Year 1 have been diving into their imaginations to create their very own versions of 'Where the Wild Things Are'. The children have produced some truly fantastic stories, showcasing their creativity and storytelling skills. In Maths, we've been learning to tell the time, focusing on o'clock and half past. In art we have created our own cubism pictures. The children have worked incredibly hard this term. Have a wonderful half term!

We've had a busy last week in Year 2. In English, we've been learning all about homophones, using conjunctions to join our ideas (both coordinating and subordinate ones), and adding detail to our sentences with expanded noun phrases. In Maths, we've been exploring volume comparing and measuring using cups, millilitres, and litres. In Science, we've been investigating different materials, thinking about what objects are made from and how some solids can be changed. Thank you for your continued support at home. Have a lovely half term break - one more week to go until we start new and exciting topics! Enjoy your half term break!

## **Day Care News**

This week in day care the children have been taking risks inside and outdoors. Linking our rhyme of the week '5 little speckled frogs' the children have been making their own frogs, using scissors to snip and cut out their frogs. They have created some fabulous leaping frogs which they were very proud to show off. They have also been outside learning to use the balancing bikes and balancing beams they created a shared adventure of avoiding crocodiles in the lake, having to balance on the bridge and not fall off.

Despite it being a short half-term, we've crammed a lot in!

This year more families are choosing to take holiday during term-time. While we understand it is cheaper to go away during term-time, if your child has a week out of school, they will miss 25 lessons. Following a holiday, we are required to send evidence (any documentation relating to the absence) to Birmingham City Council and they make the decision whether to issue a Penalty Notice (sometimes known as a fine).

We understand it's hard to hear that your child's behaviour hasn't met our expectations but ask for your continued trust and support.
