Online applicants will receive an immediate email confirmation when the application is submitted. Those online applicants who have not provided an email address will not receive an acknowledgement, so it is very important that you include an email address.

This week Willow class have been talking about our families. We learnt that families come in all different shapes and sizes. The children enjoyed talking and drawing their families. In PE this week we pretended to be different mythical creatures. We were each given a fairy (beanbag) to look after and practiced balancing it on different parts of our bodies. In Maths this week we have been building towers and looking at the properties of 3D shapes in our tower building.

This week in Reception, the children have continued with their termly topic 'Me, myself and my community'. During carpet times we have been reading 'Find Your Happy' and learning about our feelings. We have been learning all about our senses, how we use them and why they are important. During the week, we had a very special visitor to class! Miss Campbell-Kelly brought Bow, our school therapy dog into our classes so that we could meet her and learn about how she uses her senses to help her. In Maths, we have continued to learn about sorting. We have been learning to sort objects by colour, size and shape. In RWI we have been learning the sounds b, f, e, I, h.

This week Year 1 have been learning all about maps in Geography, we drew our own signpost maps and were using the language of near and far. In Maths, we have been exploring number lines, it was very fun going out into the playground and drawing our own number lines with the chalk. In English, we've been focusing on our sentence structure, ensuring we use capital letters and full stops. It's been a very busy but fun week!

This week in Year 2, we've been busy exploring numbers and objects in Maths, using greater than, less than, and equal to symbols to compare and reason. In English, we've learnt how to use past tense verbs and conjunctions to improve our writing, and we've begun our exciting new class innovation based on Zog! In Geography, we used Google Maps to plan routes around our local area, developing our understanding of place and direction. In Science, we discussed the importance of hygiene for keeping our bodies healthy and learnt about Edward Jenner's pioneering work in creating vaccines to protect us from harmful germs.

Blossom News

This week in the blossom room the children have been learning the Old McDonald rhyme, we have linked many fun activities to the theme; they has especially enjoyed using the story sac, the children have been singing the rhyme while using the puppets, and have been able to recognise the different animals and the sounds that they make. We have seen lots of imaginative play as the children have been using the small world models to make up adventures. Outside they have played fun games of find the animals having to search above, below, inside and under to seek out the animals. They have also been very creative using collage and paint to make the different characters for a wall display.


