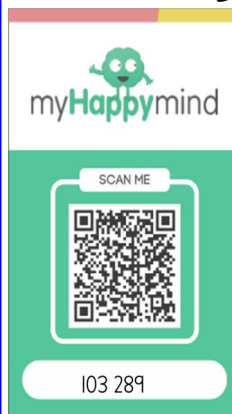
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Dear Parents & Carers

This week, we launched our first module *Meet Your Brain* and met Team H.A.P.—a fun way for children to learn about how their brain helps them think, feel, and grow.

Willow class have been reading the book '*All Are Welcome*'. We have been talking about different communities that we are a part of. We used a mirror to look at our faces and created a paper plate portrait. In PE we practiced jumping in different directions.

Reception have started their new topic of '*Me, Myself and My Community*'. They have enjoyed painting portraits of themselves and exploring mixing the primary colours and looking at their baby photos to see how they have grown and changed. In Maths we have been learning about matching and using the words same and different. In phonics the children have learnt the sounds 't' 'i' 'n' 'p'.

Year 1 have had a very exciting week! On Tuesday, we came in from breaktime to find our classrooms had been destroyed! We later received a letter from Little Red Riding Hood and found out that it was the big bad wolf! We made some wanted posters to warn everybody about it. The children were so engaged and their discussion was amazing! In Maths this week, we have been focusing on one more and one less. We are so proud of how well Year 1 have settled.



This week, Year 2 has been full of exciting learning adventures! In Maths, we've been exploring flexible partitioning of numbers up to 100, helping us understand how numbers can be broken down in different ways. Our English lessons took a magical turn with a visit to Dragon School to introduce our new class book, *Zog*. We've created a story map and discovered new vocabulary, with a special focus on the word *proud*. In Geography, we became cartographers and designed detailed maps of our school, complete with keys to show important features. Meanwhile in Art, we experimented with mixing primary colours to create warm and cool tones.

Blossom News

'The Wheels on the Bus'

This week the children in Blossom Room have been experiencing activities linked to one of our rhymes of the week "The wheels on the Bus" They have been exploring the different effects of play dough and paint and the children have created a road scene and a large bus for our wall display. We have been talking about our own experiences of being on the bus, where do we sit? up or down stairs?, buying tickets and counting the windows, doors and wheels. The children have been creating some great role play together. Outside they have been using their imagination to act out their own adventures.

Staff have also been busy assessing the children's language development, using the Wellcom programme, we have been able to identify any children who may be facing speech and language barriers. Through this we are able to plan extra support to provide fun intervention activities.
