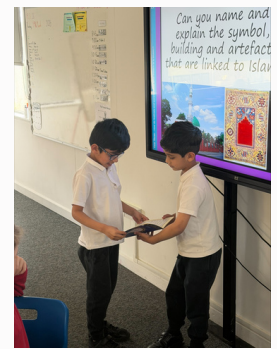
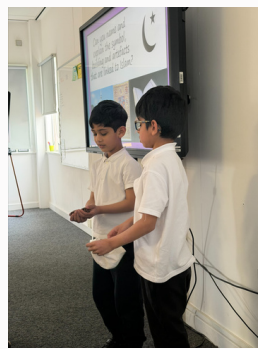
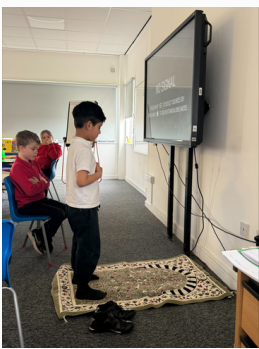
Easter Garden in Reception

More R.E. Learning in Y3



In Year 3 the children are currently learning about how festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim. Hasan brought in some artefacts from home to show everyone and he and Aayan even read the Qur'an together.

It explores religious literacy by exploring Christianity alongside other major faiths, fostering respect, and examining life's big questions.
