Dear Parents / Carers,

We would like to invite you to apply for our summer holiday clubs which this year can only be provided free of charge to pupils who are entitled to free school meals or are eligible for a school granted hardship code for which you would need to meet the set criteria. All other pupils can still attend our school clubs but this time for a small daily charge. All clubs include a free lunch and drinks / snacks throughout the day for all pupils regardless of free school meals.

Our holiday provision is very popular, so we are urging families to only apply promptly for clubs which their children can definitely attend and commit to turning up on the day. It is very frustrating when staffing and resources have been paid for and children don't show up. Holiday clubs are costly to school so if you've signed up, please show up! Non-attendance without an explanation may result in your child not being chosen for future opportunities.

Please see the information below about each of the activities:

Fun Activity Club (Free to FSM children / £5 per day to all other children)

This club will be based in the KS2 hall, please take children straight to the hall for registration at 9am. Children should be in comfortable playing out clothes and trainers. All food and activities will be provided by school, but children may wish to bring a water bottle.

Football Club (Free to FSM children / £5 per day to all other children)

We have our very own FA trained coach running football sessions for all age groups.

Go Ape (Free to FSM children / £5 to all other children)

Children need to meet Grimes Dyke staff at Go Ape – Temple Newsam at 9.30am wearing suitable clothing for climbing. Parents / carers are welcome to stay and watch or can leave children with us and return at 11.30am for collection.

Lineham Farm (Residential Visit – Free to all children)

We are very pleased to be able to offer a residential experience for children in Y2 to Y5. We will leave school on Wednesday morning at 10.15am so children need to be in school for 10am at the latest. We will spend two nights at the farm and return to school on Wednesday at 2pm.

Lineham Farm (Camping Visit – Free to all children)

We are very pleased to be able to offer a camping experience for children in Y5. We will leave school on Monday afternoon at 1.15pm so children need to be in school for 1pm at the latest. We will spend one night at the farm in tents and return to school on Tuesday at around 11.30am.

Lineham Farm Cooking (Free to FSM children / £5 to all other children)

Children will travel to Lineham Farm by bus to take part in a range of cooking activities alongside their chef and other volunteers.

Outdoor Days with Miss Hill and Ros (Free to FSM children / £5 to all other children)

It's the usual fun packed day of outdoor madness! Towards the end of the day, we will also be getting out our water slide so children will need a towel and a change of clothes.

Ninja Warrior (Free to FSM children / £5 to all other children)

Children are to meet at Ninja Warrior for a play session, this activity includes a full hot meal at Ninja Warrior and socks for all children taking part.

Festival Day! We know Team GD love a family picnic, so how about a family festival complete with stage and live acts? All families are welcome to attend and have fun with lots of activities to do and refreshments on sale. We would love to see everyone there, think Glastonbury but in Swarcliffe!
