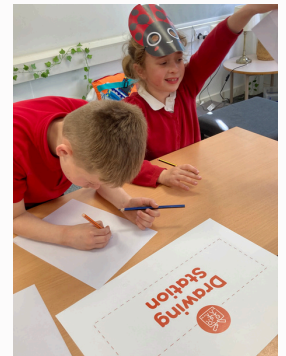

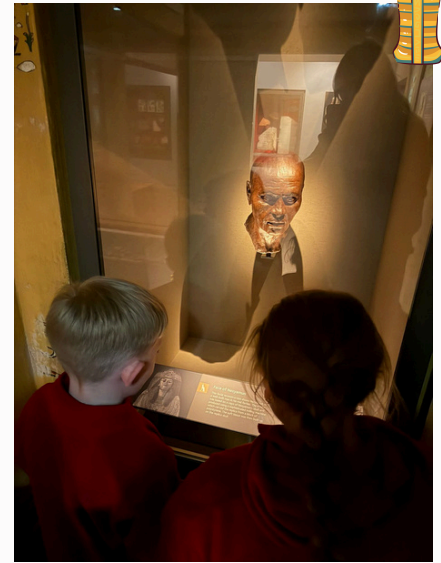
## Playgrounds of Possibility
