National Reading Week and World Book Day



Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week we will be celebrating National Reading Week. The week also includes World Book Day which is on Thursday 5th March.

We have planned lots of activities throughout the week some of which are listed below:

Tuesday 3rd March-Breakfast and a book. The school hall will be open from 8.15am for children to enjoy a 'light' breakfast and read a book.

Thursday 5th March is World Book Day. Children are invited to dress up as any character from a Julia Donaldson book.

Friday 6th March-Book Swap. Throughout the week children can bring in a book from home which they are happy to donate to the 'book swap'. On Friday lunchtime the school council will facilitate the book swap and children who have donated can choose a new book to keep.

We are also running an 'Extreme Reading Competition' which all children are invited to participate in. The challenge is for the children to photograph themselves reading in an 'extreme' way and either bring in a copy of their photo or post it on Google Classroom. There will be one winner from each class announced on World Book Day-so entries must be submitted before then. **All children MUST be accompanied by an adult when they are taking their photos and the 'extreme' element of their photo should BE SAFE!**

As we did last year, we would like to invite parent readers into school, to read a story to a class. It would be fantastic if every class had a visit from a parent during the week. If you are available and would like to come in to read during National Reading Week, please complete the slip below and the office will call you to arrange a day and time.
