This coming Sunday's Gospel tells the powerful story of the raising of Lazarus (**John 11:1–45**). It is a reminder that Jesus brings hope even in the darkest situations, and that new life can emerge where we least expect it. As Jesus calls Lazarus out of the tomb, we are invited to reflect on what holds us back, what we need to leave behind, and how we can step forward into new life with trust.

This message links to our Lenten theme in school. Just as Jesus brings light and renewal, we encourage the children to think about how their choices can bring light to others—through acts of kindness, perseverance, and care for our common home. The Big Lent Walk this week has been a wonderful way for the children to live this out: step by step, they are learning that faith is something we put into action.


