## Keeping Children Safe in the Sun

Dear Parents/Carers

### SUNCREAM

Summer is here (occasionally!) Please note the points below so that we can work together to keep our children safe.

- Please can all parents bring their child to Nursery with sun cream already applied to keep them safe in the sun. Nursery will re-apply sun cream for children on their extended day. We will provide a collection box for you to leave your child's sun cream and collect it from on their extended day. Please can [sun creams be labelled with your child's name](#)
- For 30 Hour children, please can you leave your own labelled sun cream at Nursery until the end of July. Staff will re-apply this each lunchtime.
- Unfortunately, we do not have enough sun cream for parents to use ours at the beginning of sessions on a regular basis, as we have limited supplies.

### SUNHATS

- Children should wear loose, light-coloured clothing to help keep cool and sunhats with wide brims (if possible) to avoid sunburn. [Please put your child's name in their hat.](#)
- We will create areas of shade in the garden for when children choose to play outside and will monitor children's well-being at all times, making sure children take opportunities to engage in less physical activities.
- Children have unlimited access to water and they are reminded frequently to have a drink to remain hydrated. We also have frozen treats as well to keep us cool on exceptionally hot days. Please do not send water or juice bottles in with your child.
