Dear Parents/Carers

Allergy Awareness – LITTLE NURSERY

We have a child in our Little Nursery class who has a newly diagnosed milk allergy. She is not allowed to eat or be exposed to milk or milk products. We have to ensure that all foods offered to her are safe for her to eat or be exposed to. **She could have an anaphylactic reaction if she eats or has contact with milk or milk products.** She has medication in the form of adrenaline auto injectors to help her and may need to go to hospital for emergency, life-saving treatment.

- We need your help to keep her safe and healthy so moving forwards;

LITTLE NURSERY WILL NOW BE AN ALLERGY AWARE ZONE

. We are asking you to help to support us at school by following these expectations;

- **CHILDREN NOT TO BRING THEIR OWN FOOD OR DRINKS INTO LITTLE NURSERY. THE TEAM WILL PROVIDE AND MONITOR MILK BASED PRODUCTS FOR SNACK-TIME.**
- Talking to your child and modelling safe eating and encouraging them to eat their own food only.
- Encouraging your child to wash their hands with soap thoroughly before and every time after eating, so they don't get any crumbs/splashes on anything in the classroom.
- Ensuring that you don't send cake or sweet treats into school for birthdays.
