PRIORY COMMON SCHOOL TRIP TO THE HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT
MONDAY 2ND FEBRUARY 2026

Dear Parents/ Carers

I am delighted to announce that we have organised a visit to The House of Parliament for year two. This visit is scheduled to take place on Monday 2nd February 2026 and will offer our students a unique opportunity to explore the grounds of The UK parliament.

During their time at The House of Parliament, our students will have the chance to have a unique guided tour. They will learn about what Parliament means, why people work there, and how rules help everyone live safely and fairly. The children also learn about the King, the House of Commons, and the House of Lords. The guide explains how adults talk about ideas and make decisions.

The Children will need to arrive to Priory Common School for 7 - 7.10 am. The coach will be promptly leave at 7.20 to ensure that we are in London in time. We will not be able to wait for any late arrivals. Late arrivals will need to attend school as normal. When arriving in London we will have a short walk to the venue.

Before returning home we will have lunch. We will be leaving London at 12.30pm and should arrive at back to school at 14.30 pm. Children to be collected from school at normal pick up time of 3.10pm unless informed otherwise by the school office.

This trip will be fully funded by school. To ensure the success and safety of this visit, we kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines:

1. Please complete and return the enclosed consent form and permission slip by Friday 23rd January.
2. Please ensure that your child is dressed in school uniform with a weather appropriate coat.
3. Your child will need a disposable pack lunch; this can be ordered via parent mail.
4. Please provide your child with a named **disposable** water bottle.
5. Spending money will not be required as there is no gift shop on site.
