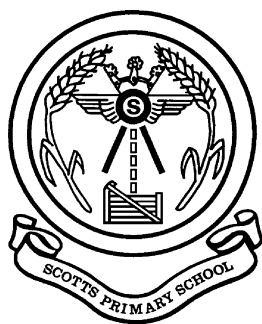

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Drew and his football team, One Touch, have won a total of four tournaments in the last few weeks. The whole team played really well against some tough opposition. Well done to all the boys!

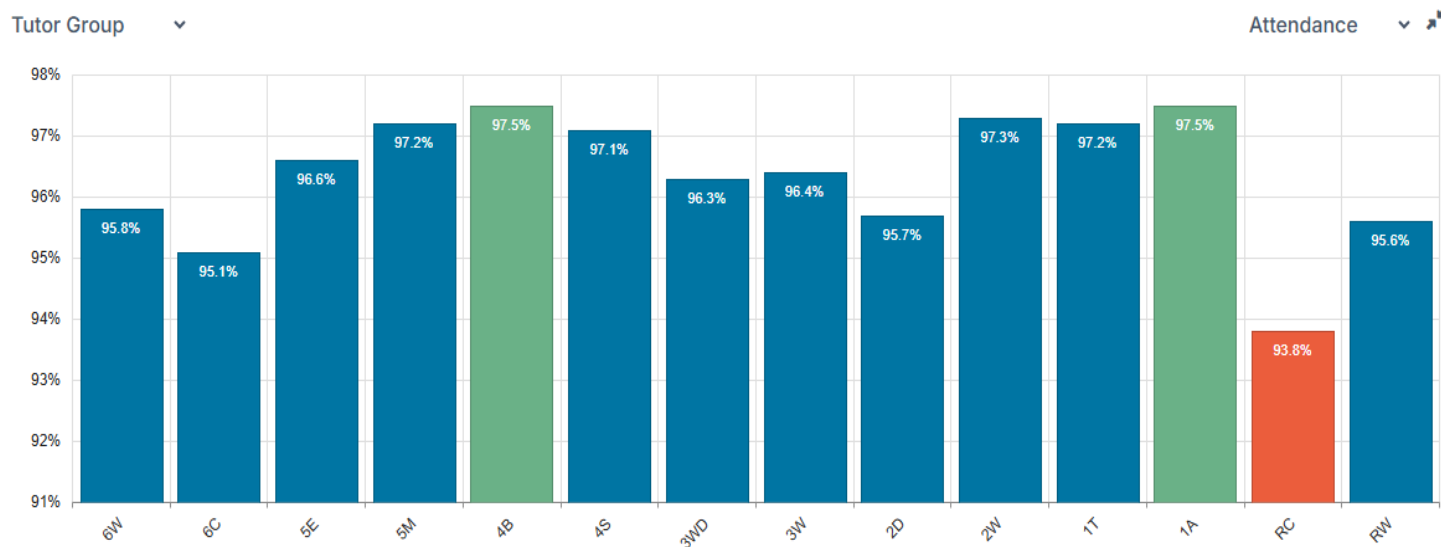
