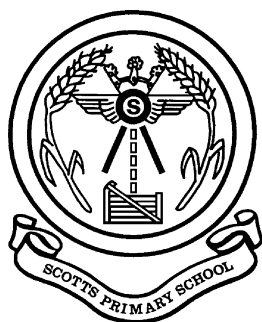

On 5th May, he competed in his first tournament in High Wycombe and secured 3rd place in his weight category.

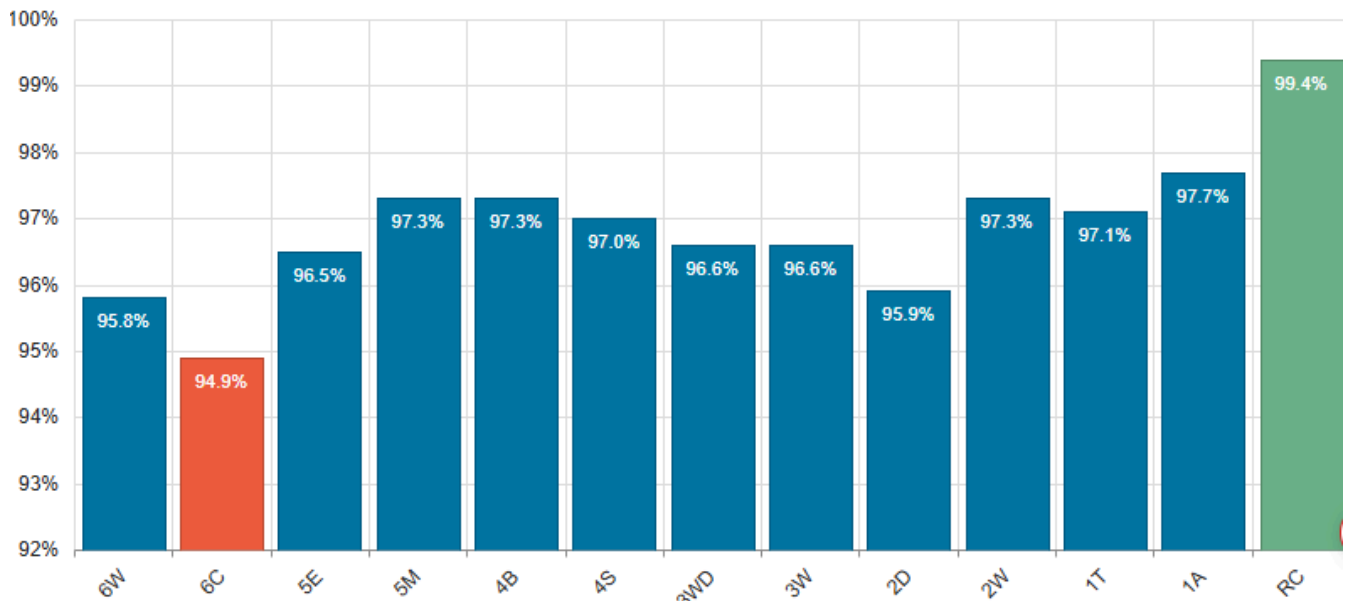
On 28th May, he was awarded "Best Player of the Month" at Ford Judo Club and received a medal in recognition of his dedication and progress.
