### Year 5 & 6 - Cyber Security Workshop

On Thursday, our Year 5 and 6 pupils received a fascinating visit from PC Smith of the Metropolitan Police Cyber Crime Team. The session focused on the essentials of staying safe online, covering password security, digital permission laws and the vital importance of protecting personal privacy. The children were particularly surprised to learn that a password created from three random words, combined with numbers and symbols, is one of the toughest defences against cyber criminals! To keep the conversation going at home, PC Smith recommended these resources:

- [Password Monster](#): Test how long it would take a computer to crack your password.
- [Cyber Land](#): An interactive game designed to teach older primary pupils the basics of cyber security.
