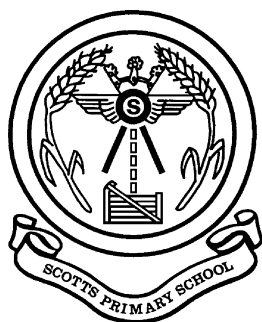

Good To Be Different Day

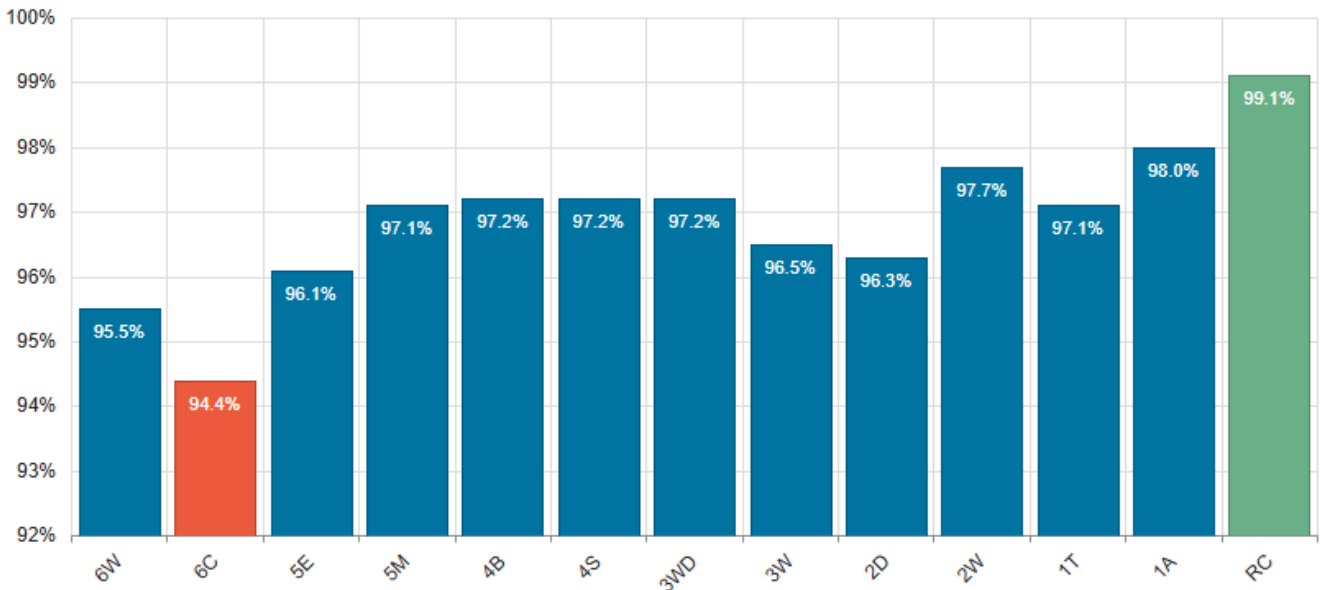
