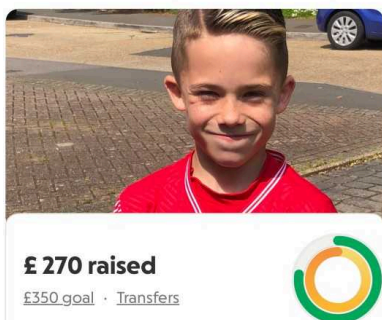
London Mini Marathon

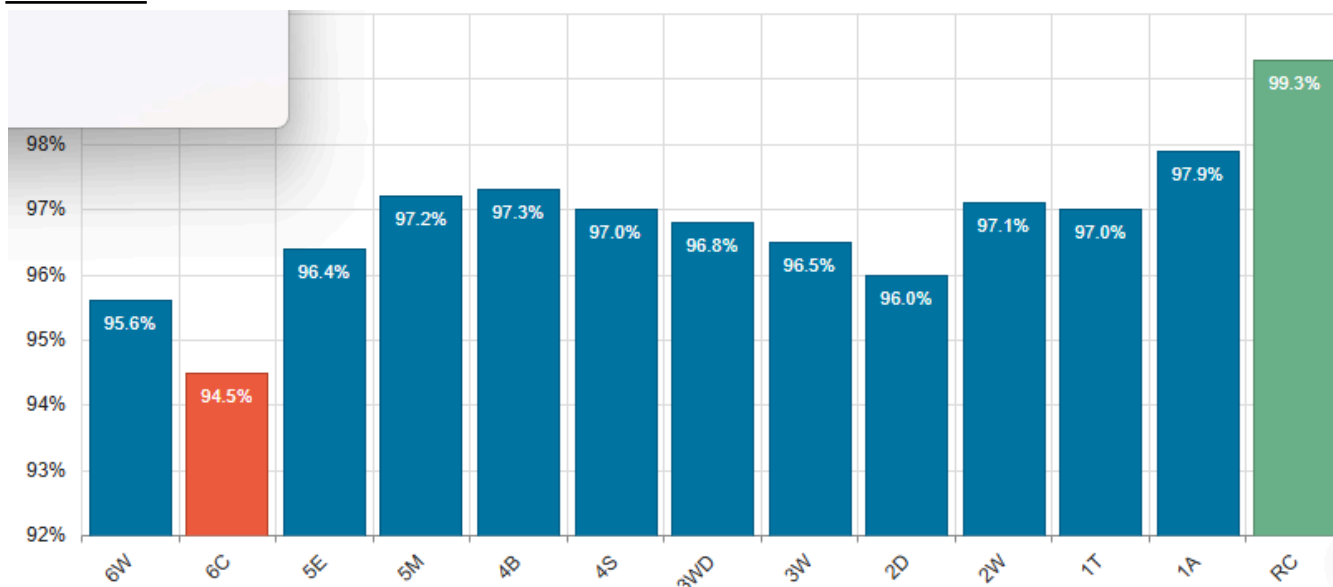
