### Nut Free Nursery

## SUNFLOWER ROOM



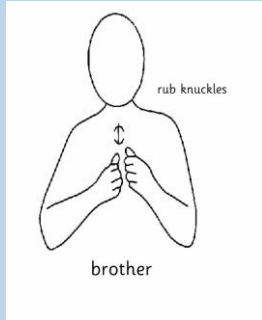
