Nut Free Nursery

We have a child with a nut allergy.

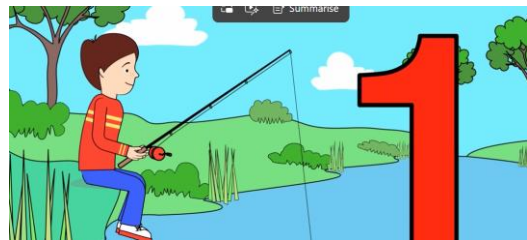


RAINBOW ROOM
