



English

Our first unit of work this year is 'Africa, Amazing Africa'. After that we will be doing a three week narrative unit of work and a two week unit on reports. We will be reading a range of different texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Our class reader this term is Once.



PE

In indoor PE, we will be focusing on dance and gymnastics and outside PE we will focus on netball and football.

History / Geography

In the first term we will be focusing on geography fieldwork and the second term our history topic is World War 2.



MFL - Spanish

We will be recapping some of the key vocabulary and focusing on 'the family' and 'the weather'



Mathematics

We will start with place value, factors, multiples and prime numbers. We will explore mental and written methods for all 4 operations and problem solving. Then we will look at fractions, decimals and percentages. Shape properties and angles will also be covered. Multiplication and general arithmetic will also be covered weekly.



Science

In Science, we will be learning about electricity, exploring conductors and insulators and factors which affect a bulb's brightness. We will also be learning about light and how it helps us to see.



Computing

We will be focusing largely on e-safety, exploring the benefits and risks of different digital devices and also exploring our digital footprint.



The Arts



In DT we will be making a wire loop game and in Art we will be making pinch pots.

In Music we will be listening, learning and appraising a range of songs that make us feel happy.
