Included in English is Reading (independent, group reading and class reading), Writing and SPaG.

Then we will investigate the styles and voices of traditional story language in fables and look at recounts. In the second half of the term, we will look at plays, poetry and instructions. We will be reading a range of different texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Mathematics

We will start by revising the work on place value and regrouping, counting on and back in Ones, Tens and Hundreds and calculating within 20. Then we will focus on adding and subtracting using mental methods and problem solving. We will also look at measurements and shape properties.

Multiplication and general arithmetic will also be covered weekly.



Curriculum Overview Year 3 Autumn Term



PSHE

We will begin by doing work around getting to know each other, class social bonding, new routines and emotional wellbeing. Then we will look at making the right choices and celebrating differences.



Science

In Science we will be looking at light (reflected from surfaces) and how shadows are formed. We will also be comparing and grouping different types of rocks and learning about fossils.



Computing

In computing, we will be learning about coding, online safety and spreadsheets.





The Arts
