



Getting Outdoors

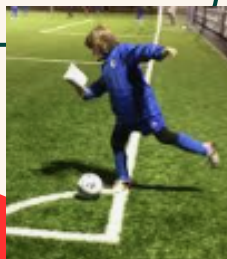
