### Creative Chloe in the Brain House

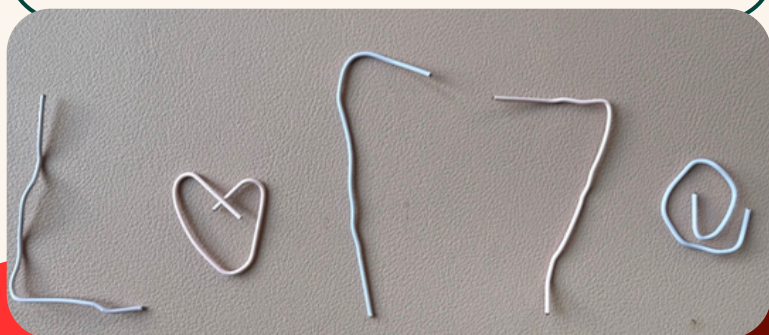
