### Inauguration of the Church of Mary of the Isle, Douglas, IOM

On Friday November 3rd the Church of Mary of the Isle, Douglas became a co-cathedral for the Archdiocese of Liverpool, alongside the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King, based 80 miles away in Liverpool City Centre, and will be the first Catholic co-cathedral in the British Isles. Pope Francis granted Cathedral status to the Church, after the announcement that Douglas had been awarded City status as part of the late Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations in June 2022.

To mark the occasion there are commemorative cards in the porch should you wish to take one home.
