John the Baptist's mission was to point people to Jesus but when the moment comes for John to baptise Jesus he was uneasy because he recognised that he was standing before someone much greater than himself. When asked to minister to Jesus, John feels unqualified and unworthy for such a task. Jesus explains that this is necessary; a sign for the beginning of his ministry and a statement of who he is.

Often we are all too aware of our unworthiness and our feelings of inadequacy. They can stop us from carrying out our mission and vocation. Several years ago Pope Francis reminded Christians that through our baptism:

'We are all part of the Church. If you say you believe in God, and if you say you believe in God but not in the Church, you're saying you don't believe in yourself, and that's a contradiction. We all are the Church, all of us. From that little child recently baptised to the bishops & Pope, all of us'.

We need to think about what our baptism means for us, that moment when we were sent out to play our part in our local community and in the world, sent out to minister to those around us, even if we feel unworthy for such a task.
