The Lateran Basilica is the official cathedral of the Pope, the Bishop of Rome, giving it the highest rank among all Catholic churches.

The feast day encourages unity among all Christians with the Pope and with each other through the universal Church.

The basilica, originally consecrated in the 4th century, is a powerful symbol of the freedom to worship, which early Christians gained after centuries of persecution.

The dedication also reminds the faithful that the Church is a living body, with each believer being a **"temple of God" built on the foundation of Jesus Christ.**
