The citation for the Military Cross, at Monte Cassino

"On 6th April 1944, Rev Kelleher was at 1 RIrF's Bttn HQ in the Cairra area when heavy shelling was reported in the village of Cairra causing several casualties to one of the platoons. Rev Kelleher immediately raced to the village which was under heavy shelling. He found the wounded men and assisted the stretcher bearers in their work, carrying men in his arms, at great personal risk, to the shelter of a ruined building.

Born in Rathmore, Co Kerry 1909

Ordained 3rd June 1934

Curate at All Saints, Golborne, until 1940

Chaplain to the Forces until his death

Served in North Africa, Sicily, Italy, Canal Zone and the South of England

Awarded the MC and appointed MBE.

During his time in Golborne Fr. Kelleher made many friends who were saddened and shocked by his death. Today's mass intention marks the 70th Anniversary of his death on 15th June 1956 in a road accident in Berlin.
