### Golborne Miners Parade & Memorial Service Sunday 17th March

This year marks the 45th anniversary of the Golborne Pit disaster on 18th March 1979 in which 10 men lost their lives and another was seriously injured. The procession will meet at 1.30pm outside the Queen Anne Public House, setting off at 2pm. It will be led by Golborne Brass Band and the Mayors of St Helens and Wigan.

A service will then take place from 2.30pm, conducted by the clergy of Golborne Speaker Rt. Revd Geoffrey Pearson, Assistant Bishop of Liverpool.

After the service, a re-union event is planned at Golborne Parkside Community Sports Club on Rivington Avenue, Golborne. A shuttle bus will be provided between the service and Golborne Parkside for those without transport.
