Children

I agree to:

- Wear the school uniform, including proper school shoes (not trainers).
- Treat other people and their property with respect.
- Talk at home about what I learn at school.
- Read my book to someone at home.
- Do all my homework and catch up with any work that I miss.
- Walk to school, whenever possible.
- Lead a healthy lifestyle, whenever possible.

Parent/Carers

I/we shall:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and to avoid all unnecessary absences during time term.
- Ensure that my child arrives on time and is collected promptly at the end of the school day.
- Ensure my child starts the day with a good breakfast.
- Ensure my child wears correct school uniform, including school shoes.
- Send my child to school, prepared for the school day with all books, equipment, PE and Forest School kit.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour and equal opportunities.
- Support my child in their home learning and promote opportunities for learning at home by reading with them regularly.
- Ensure my child goes to bed at a reasonable time on weekdays.
- Attend parent/carer evenings and other discussions about my child's progress at school.
- Keep the school informed about any issues that may affect my child's learning.
- Encourage my child to lead a healthy lifestyle, whenever possible.
- Communicate with all staff at Willowcroft in a respectful manner
- Encourage my child to take advantage of the opportunities offered, both educational and extra-curricular.
- Be respectful of other people's privacy by only placing comments and pictures of my own child/children on social media sites.
- Not use social media to post complaints, concerns or issues relating to my child specifically; I will use the appropriate pastoral channels (Amanda Jones, Class Teachers or Senior Leaders) for these.
- Acknowledge that Willowcroft does not want mobile phones in school (unless you have a signed permission slip) and is not liable for any loss.

• Ensure I park and behave respectfully to local residents, when dropping off and collecting my child from school.

School

Staff at the school will:

- Provide a high standard of education for your child to enable them to achieve their best.
- Care for your child's safety and happiness.
- Provide a safe learning environment, where the welfare of children and safeguarding are promoted.
- Deliver a balanced, creative and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child and which reflects the school's vision.
- Provide a range of after school extracurricular activities designed to enrich your child's experience.
- Encourage your child to have a growth mind set.
- Ensure that all home learning activities are given out regularly on an agreed day and that they will reflect your child's learning needs.
- To actively welcome parent/carers and grandparents into the life of the school and ensure that teaching staff are always available, by mutual agreement, to discuss any concerns you might have about your child's progress or welfare.
- Keep you informed about the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour and equal opportunities, other school matters and in particular about your child's progress.
- Ensure that all staff keep up to date on important educational developments and initiatives which may affect your child, and to inform you of these where appropriate.
- Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich the children's school experience.
- Promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs and for those without faith.

Governors

Our Governors will carry out their legal responsibilities to the school and ensure:

- That school policies provide care for every pupil.
- That funding received by the school will be used responsibly to provide the curriculum and support services our school needs.
- That they will meet regularly to carry out their function.
- That they will visit the school regularly.
