Thank you to the grown ups who volunteered to help.





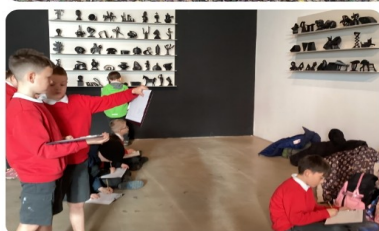
