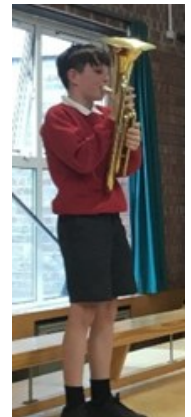

Fortnightly Safeguarding Update

Safeguarding Update: Social Media Changes for Children

We would like to make parents aware of important upcoming national changes regarding children's use of social media.

The UK Government has announced that, from **Spring 2027**, children under the age of 16 will no longer be able to access a number of major social media platforms. These are expected to include popular apps such as Instagram, TikTok, Snapchat, Facebook, YouTube and X (formerly Twitter).

This change is designed to improve online safety for children. The aim is to reduce young people's exposure to harmful content, online bullying and features that can negatively affect wellbeing.

Alongside this:

- Social media companies will be required to introduce stronger age checks.
- Features such as livestreaming and contact from strangers will be restricted for under-16s and limited for older teenagers.

Children will still be able to use the internet for learning, gaming and communicating with known friends and family, for example through messaging apps.

At this stage, these changes are not yet in force, but it is helpful for families to be aware of what is coming and begin to consider how children use technology at home.

As a school, we strongly encourage parents to:

- Be aware of the age restrictions on apps your child is using
- Talk regularly with your child about online safety and respectful behaviour
- Use parental controls where appropriate

Remind children never to communicate with people they do not know online. We will continue to support pupils with age-appropriate online safety education in school and will share further updates with families as national guidance develops.


