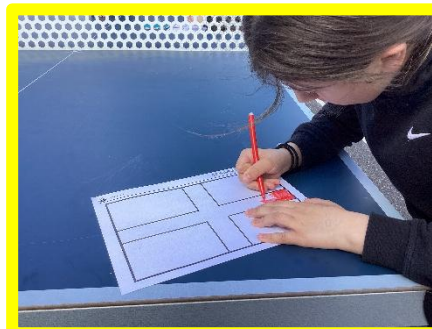

The food will be prepared by the school kitchen and served to pupils at the start of morning playtime.

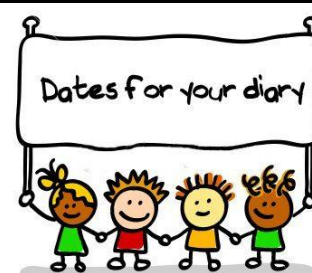
