The Pearl of Africa Children's Choir is a vibrant group of young singers drawn from the Molly & Paul Childcare Foundation schools in Uganda. Their mission is two-fold: to develop musical talent in the children, and to help raise funds to support education, health, and community development projects in Uganda.

What Makes Them Special?

Roots and Purpose

The choir is composed of children who benefit from Molly & Paul's work across several communities in Uganda. The Choir tours internationally so that wider audiences can enjoy their music—and so that funds can be raised to help schools, nutrition, healthcare, and school infrastructure back home.

Musical Style

Expect powerful harmonies, joyful rhythms, traditional African songs and instruments, and energetic dance. Their performances offer a window into Ugandan culture and the talents of the young people themselves.

Impact

Through their tours, the Choir helps bring attention, resources, and global support to children who might otherwise lack opportunities for education and a healthy childhood.
