to a direct debit. As a school we are billed by School Grid and if you do not pay for your child's dinners school then has to cover the cost which takes money away from much needed resources in other areas for our children. If your child's dinner account is in arrears, please ensure you provide your child with a packed lunch until the debt has been cleared.
