School Dinners:

Packed Lunches:

Please ensure that these do not contain fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate bars

Snack:

FROM SEPTEMBER SNACK WILL BE FRUIT ONLY

KS1 – all children will have access to free fruit as a snack. If you prefer to send something in **please send a piece of fresh fruit only**. No snack money will be collected.

KS2 – If your child would like a snack at break time please send a piece of fresh fruit only.

Water Bottles:

All children should bring in a small clear plastic water bottle.

We sell these in the school office for £1.

Please do not send in larger vessels such as Stanley cups / Air up bottles etc. These are too big and cumbersome for the children to have at their desks and do not fit in the carriers that we use to store the bottles.

Uniform:

Please continue to ensure school uniform policy is adhered to:

- No trainers (except PE days)
- No earrings at all.
- No smart watches.

PE Kit:

Children should continue to come into school in their PE kits on the days they have PE. School PE kits should only be worn (maroon shorts or grey joggers /black leggings, white t-shirt, school hoodie or school jumper)

Bags:

Please do not send in large rucksacks or bags – we have no space to store them

Scooters / Bikes:

Only children in Y6 who have completed their Bikeability training are permitted to come to school on bikes.

We cannot store bikes or scooters during the school day.
