We have seen a large increase in the number of children's dinner accounts going into arrears. As with any meal purchased, school dinners are no different. School dinners **MUST** be paid for in advance, unless you are signed up to a direct debit. As a school we are billed by School Grid and if you do not pay for your child's dinners school then has to cover the cost which takes money away from much needed resources in other areas for our children. If your child's dinner account is in arrears, please ensure you provide your child with a packed lunch until the debt has been cleared.
