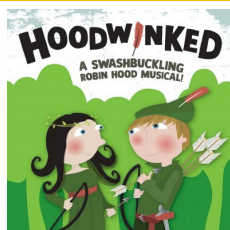


Sports Day will go ahead this Friday (3rd July) from 9:15 to 11:15am, weather permitting. Should this need to change, we will update you.

We are delighted to have secured English Hub funding to enable us to enhance our current phonics provision. The funding will enable us to invest in:

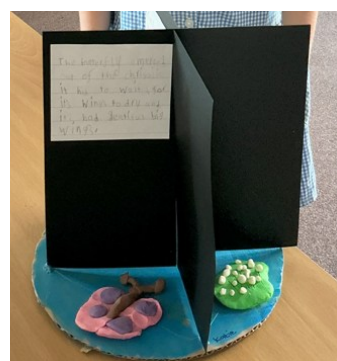
- Decodable books that align with our phonics scheme that can be sent home for Ruby and Sapphire pupils.
