Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that several children in Sapphire Class have recently been diagnosed with chickenpox. While this is a common childhood illness, we want to ensure all families are aware so that you can monitor your child for any symptoms.

Chickenpox typically begins with mild flu-like symptoms, followed by an itchy rash of small, fluid-filled blisters. **If your child develops symptoms, please keep them at home until all spots have scabbed over, which usually takes about five days from the onset of the rash.**
