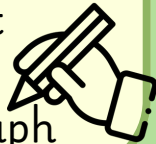

Pupils will learn about how light works and shadows are made.

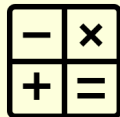

Curriculum questions to ask at home



1. What is a human feature? Give one example in Bury.
