What do you want your portrait to say about you?

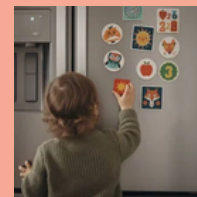


Create a timeline of events to show the key moments in the history of the Suffragettes.
