Pupils will learn how electricity works through working with circuits.

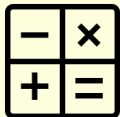

Curriculum questions to ask at home



1. What is a human feature? Give one example in Bury.

Answer: A human feature is something made by people, like a building or a road. Example: Bury Market.

2. What is a physical feature? Give one example near Bury.

Answer: A physical feature is something natural, like a river or hill. Example: River Irwell.

3. Is a school a human or physical feature?

Answer: A school is a human feature.

4. What happens in winter?

Answer: It gets colder, the days are shorter, and we may see snow or frost.

5. What season comes after spring?

Answer: Summer comes after spring.

6. Name a material and something it is used to make.

Answer: Wood – used to make tables and chairs.

Answer: They used horses, carts, or steam trains.

9. What is one way travel has changed over time?
