LEARNING LOG

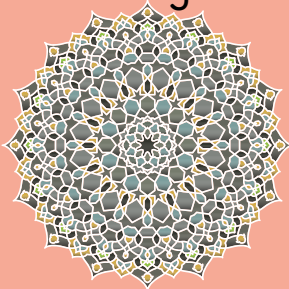


Create a comic strip which explains why the Golden Age of Islam came to an end.
