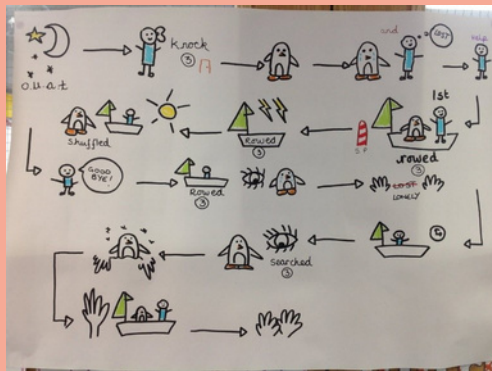
Create a piece of artwork to show an animal that lives in a hot or cold place.
