Pupils will learn about how the police force has changed over time in our locality, the importance of Sir Robert Peel and compare to modern-day policing.

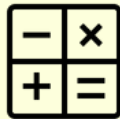
Science Animals

Curriculum questions to ask at home



1. What is a village?

2. What is a town?

3. What is a city?

Answer: A city is a very large settlement with many people, tall buildings and busy roads.

4. Is Bury a village, town or city?

Answer: Bury is a town.

5. What type of settlement would have the most buildings—village, town or city?

Answer: A city has the most buildings.

6. Which type of settlement is usually quieter with more countryside nearby—village or city?

Answer: A village is usually quieter.

7. What is the name of the famous market in Bury where people have shopped for many years?

Answer: Bury Market.

8. What form of transport brought big changes to Bury during the Industrial period?

Answer: The railway.

9. What part of the human body is used for hearing sounds?

Answer: The ears.

10. What part of the body helps us smell?

Answer: The nose.

11. Name one body part that humans and many animals both have.

Answer: Humans and animals both have legs. (or eyes, ears, mouths etc.)

12. What do animals need their legs for?

Answer: Animals use their legs for moving and walking.
