#### Applying for a Secondary School Place

Applications are now open, you **must** apply for a secondary school place by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025. A letter with more information was sent home earlier this week. National Offer day is Monday, 2nd March 2026.

Secondary schools offer Open Evenings where you generally are able to meet staff, take a tour of the school and ask any questions you might have about your child making the transition to secondary school. Full dates and times are published on school websites.

#### Forest School

Please provide your child with appropriate outdoor clothing for Forest School sessions. They will always need a waterproof coat and outdoor shoes. Waterproof trousers are desirable and hats and gloves for when the weather turns colder.
