## Helping Phonic Leaders to develop phonic practice and early reading in school

Burley Woodhead C of E Primary has been designated by the DfE as the primary English Hub, covering Bradford, and North Yorkshire. Our remit is to support schools with early language development, age appropriate phonics provision and promoting a love of reading.

Burley Woodhead English Hub is offering a series of 5 free, short online workshops to help Phonic Leads develop phonic practice and early reading in their school. The online workshops are aimed at Phonic Leads and may be particularly useful if you are new to this role. There is an expectation that each delegate will sign up to all 5 of the sessions below. There will be small gap tasks between sessions to help you ensure best practice is taking place within your school. These free sessions will run remotely on Zoom, after school, time to be confirmed once we know numbers.

This free course will be limited to a maximum of 20 places and places will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. We anticipate this event will fill up quickly.
