We are so excited to be able to offer your children a delicious, warm, homemade meal again from Monday!

Our 2 week rolling menus are available on Class Dojo and on our website. If you would like a paper version, please get in touch. Children order their meals in the morning register and there is always the option of a baked potato if they do not want the menu option.

If your child is in year 3, 4 or 5 they no longer receive Universal Free School meals, unless they're eligible for income based Free School Meals. School meals cost £2.20 per day and you can pay daily, weekly or $\frac{1}{2}$ termly. Please send money in a named envelope/bag.

Please apply for income based Free School Meals using the following link and if your child is eligible, you will be notified in writing and all meals & school milk will be free to you. You will also receive supermarket vouchers to help with groceries/uniform throughout school holidays whilst Northumberland County Council provides this.
