At Mulgrave Primary School, we believe that a school uniform supports positive behaviour, fosters a sense of belonging, and promotes equality among pupils. All children are expected to follow our uniform expectations, which have been designed to be smart, practical and accessible for families.

Uniform Supplier

Our official uniform supplier is **Price and Buckland**, and uniform can be ordered directly online:

Uniform orders are delivered directly to your home address.

The only items that must carry the school logo are **royal blue sweatshirts and cardigans**. Families may purchase all other uniform items from local shops (e.g., plain polo shirts or trousers from supermarkets).

School Uniform Expectations

Main Uniform

- Black or dark grey skirts or trousers
- White or blue polo shirt
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan (logoed preferred/required)
- White, black or grey socks or tights

- Plain flat black shoes or plain black trainers
 - *No coloured soles, laces or designs*
 - Shoes must be flat, sturdy and suitable for active play
 - High heels or shoes with thin straps are not permitted for safety reasons

Warmer Weather (Summer Term)

- Black or grey skirts, shorts or trousers
- Blue and white gingham dress
- White or blue polo shirt
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black shoes or trainers



P.E. and Games Kit

Indoor PE

- Black shorts or leggings
- White T-shirt
- Pumps or trainers
- **No baggy or hooded clothing** is permitted for indoor PE in line with health and safety guidance

Outdoor PE Kit

- Black/grey shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Green logo PE T-shirt

- Jumper (school jumper or a plain jumper from home may be worn in winter months, worn over the PE T-shirt)
- Trainers (not school shoes)
- Astroturf trainers for use on the MUGA

PE kits may be kept in school during the week in a clearly labelled kit bag.

Additional Expectations

- **All clothing and belongings must be clearly labelled**, including coats, PE kit and bags. Sew-in labels or indelible pens are recommended.
 - **Jewellery:** Only plain stud earrings may be worn. No other jewellery or make-up is permitted.
 - **Hats:** Sun hats or warm winter hats may be worn outside when appropriate.

Reception Children

Reception children follow the main school uniform expectations listed above. In addition, they will need the following:

Items to bring during the first week (to be kept in school):

- Spare clothes (not uniform) in a labelled bag
- Wellington boots (labelled)
- Navy blue waterproof suit and jacket (to remain in school)

Items to bring daily:

- Labelled water bottle
- School uniform (worn daily)
- School book bag
- Coat

Please note: Children do not need additional bags. Spare clothes stay in the classroom, and parents will be notified if replacements are required.

PE Kit for Reception

- PE kit is only needed **from the Spring Term onwards**.

Nursery Children

Nursery children may wear their own comfortable, practical clothing suitable for the nursery setting. Families are welcome to purchase Mulgrave uniform for nursery-aged children if they wish to do so.
