This week, our spotlight is on Physical Education and the important role it plays in promoting healthy, active lifestyles. At Peel Brow, we provide a broad and engaging PE curriculum that helps pupils develop a wide range of physical and personal skills. Children build fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping, throwing and catching in the early years, before progressing to more advanced techniques in games, gymnastics, dance and athletics as they move through the school. Pupils also learn the importance of teamwork, communication, resilience and sportsmanship, as well as developing their confidence through participation in swimming and competitive activities. We are proud of the enthusiasm our children show in PE lessons and the positive attitudes they bring to staying active, supporting their physical and mental wellbeing both in school and beyond.

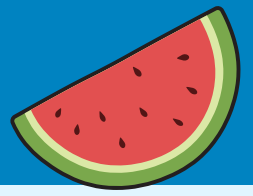
Come and See....!



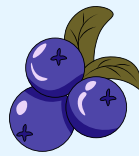

SAFEGUARDING UPDATE

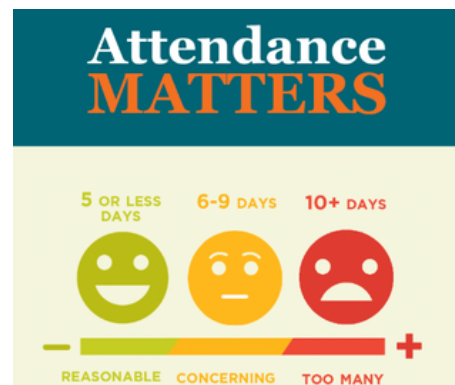
